GENERAL INFORMATION

We have three levels for you to explore: our museum, the orchestra/main level of the theatre and our balcony/second level of the theatre.

We will have various hands-on activities in the museum, theatre and lobby.

There are videos playing in our museum.

This event includes a performance of *One Destiny*. The performance is about 40 minutes long. There is no intermission. The performance will begin at 9:45 a.m.

This performance contains:

• Some loud noises, including the sound of a gunshot.

CHECK IN

Our friendly staff will welcome you and scan your tickets at a table located in our main lobby.

All tickets for Ford's For Me are held under the patron's name and can be picked up upon arrival at the check in table.

SEATING

Seating for *One Destiny* is general admission, which means you do not have an assigned seat. Wheelchair accessible seating is available in the last rows of both the orchestra and balcony levels.

GETTING TO FORD'S

Ford's Theatre is located at 511 10th Street, NW, Washington, D.C. 20004.

Riding Metro:

• On the Red, Blue, Silver and Orange lines, use the Metro Center station and exit at the

11th and G Streets exit. It is a 3-minute walk to 10th and F Streets.

• On the Yellow and Green lines, use the Gallery Place/Chinatown station and use the Gallery Place exit. It is a 5-minute walk to 10th and F Streets.

Parking:

Limited metered parking is available in the surrounding blocks of Ford's Theatre.

The closest parking garage is located on 10th Street, NW just south of F Street, NW. This parking garage has an elevator that connects to the Ford's Theatre lobby. Weekend parking is a flat rate of \$23. Ford's Theatre does not validate parking.
